MAIN ACTIVITIES DIRECTION

Having proofed contacts with European donors, since 2014 our main directions were assisting medical institutions with expensive equipment and supporting the military and civilian population aid. After Russian full invasion on the territory of Ukraine in February 2022, military aid became our main focus.

1 Military aid

Expensive medical equipment, medical beds, medicines, ambulances

Assistance to medical institutions is one of the main direction of our activity. Having built up over the years, constant proofed partnership relations with many donors in Europe, we have been constantly receiving aid for medical institutions of Ukraine since 2014.

Our mission is to provide emergency and scheduled medical care to unprotected categories of civilian Ukrainians, namely children, persons with disabilities and lonely elderly people who suffered as a result of hostilities and occupation.

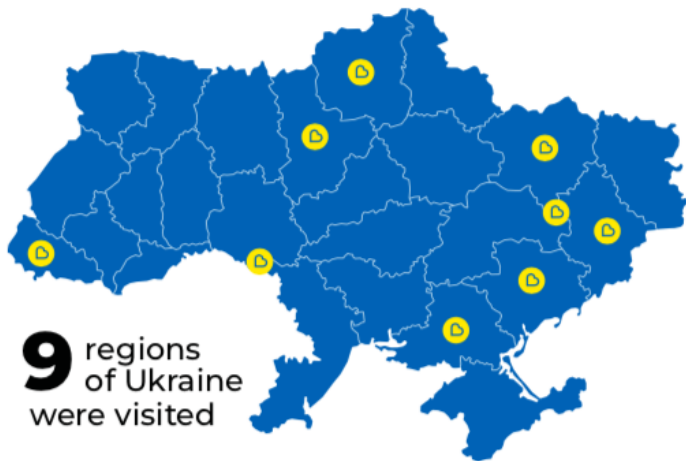
The team works in three main directions: **outpatient receptions, evacuation, and training of volunteers.**

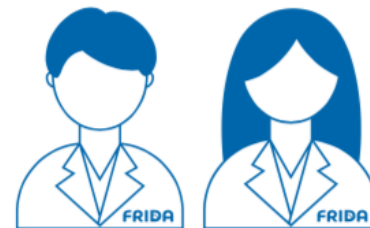

PLANS FOR THE YEAR



→ Carrying out 2 outpatient visits by a team of 20-30 people for 2 days, as well as 1 evacuation.

→ Cooperation with the Evgeny Pyvovarov Foundation: carrying out 5 monthly trips to small communities, villages, and towns in the Kharkiv region.

→ Organization of 48 evacuations during the year with the German partner Paramedic-Brandenburg e.V.

→ Together with the Polish Medical Mission, the creation of 5 mobile clinics in the front-line villages of the Kharkiv region, where there is no medical infrastructure. Each clinic has workplaces for 2 doctors and 2 nurses.

→ Together with NSU named after O.O. Bogomolets organization of 2 medical trainings every month.

→ Facilitating advanced training of 50 doctors in Israel every year.

→ Support and maintenance of international medical organizations, for example, SUPERHUMANS.

→ Organization of 24 trainings on psychological assistance for doctors, volunteers and all those who provide assistance by IsraAID.

- Purchase of portable ultrasound devices for mobile missions;
- Purchase of ophthalmic equipment;

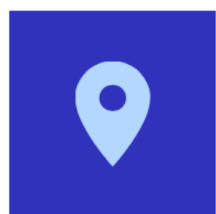

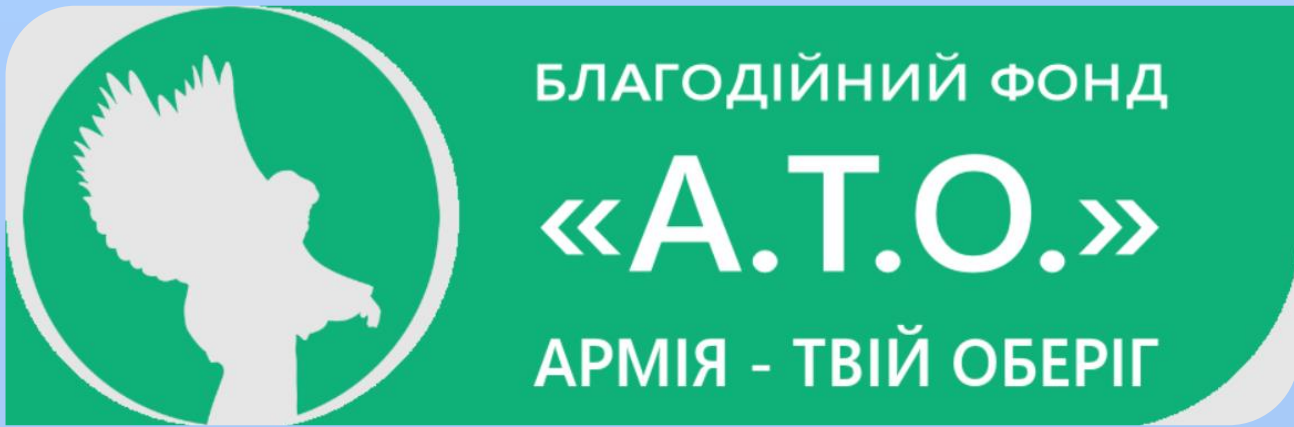

Taskforce-Projekt zur medizinischen Ausbildung

Ebenfalls im Februar veranstaltete die Taskforce zusammen mit ATLS Switzerland einen Online-Kurs über die Grundsätze der erweiterten Trauma-Lebenshilfe. schaffung von medizinischem Material, mit Beratung bei der Therapie komplexer Patientinnen und bei der Weiterbildung. Einige Spitäler haben Partnergruppen in der Schweiz, von denen sie unterstützt werden. In der Ukraine arbeiten sie derzeit mit rund sechs Spitalern zusammen. Darunter Chornohyrd, dem größten Kinderhospital der Ukraine in Kiev.

Austausch von medizinischen Wissen: Auf Wunsch unserer ukrainischen Kolleginnen haben wir zusammen mit der ATLS Switzerland eine Kurzerfahrung des «Advanced Trauma Life Support»-Kurses auf Zoom erstellt. Die Teilnahme haben wir in Zusammenarbeit mit Swiss Medix Kids und der Ukrainischen Gesellschaft für Pädiatrie die «Advanced Paediatric Life Support»-Kursreihe in die ukrainische Sprache übersetzt. Die Videos waren ein Erfolg – mehr als 150 ukrainische Ärztinnen haben sich angemeldet, um anhand der Videos zu lernen.

Unterstützung der Gesundheitsfachrichtungen: Von Anfang an hat sich die Taskforce daran beteiligt, die notwendigen medizinische Ausstattung bereitzustellen und in die Ukraine zu transportieren. Seit März 2022 haben wir mehr als 123 Tonnen an Hilfsgütern geliefert. Darunter waren 80 Beatmäter und 20 Geräte für die Rehabilitation sowie Ausrichtung für Intensivstationen.

Förderung für junge Patientinnen und ihre Familien: Wir sichern die medizinische Evaluation von Kindern und haben eine Checkliste erstellt, um junge Patientinnen und ihre Familien rascher an einen sicheren Ort überführen zu können.

Unterstützung von Neugeborenen: In der Ukraine werden täglich schätzungsweise mehr als 800 Babys geboren, die in Kriegszustand mit besonderen Herausforderungen konfrontiert sind. So hat die neonatologische Abteilung von Chornohyrd seit Beginn des Krieges mehr als 1000 eigene Neugeborenen betreut, trotz der widrigen Umstände. In frontnahen Orten ist die Situation für die Mütter und ihre Neugeborenen noch schwieriger. Deshalb haben wir ihnen in diesem Winter Hilfspakete geschickt, die jeweils einen Babystrahlensack und eine Körnerflasche enthalten. Aufgrund der

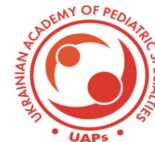
Prior to co-founding Testasy, Jeyla worked at BP and later at McKinsey & Company, where her primary focus was digitalization in Oil & Gas and Renewable Energy, and where she worked with multinational oil companies and governments deploying Digital solutions for more efficient, less toxic energy production and conservation practices Jeyla holds an honors degree from Imperial College London

We united our industry partners under “Hack4Health”

Hack4Health is an alliance of entrepreneurial individuals and organizations dedicated to providing meaningful assistance to communities in need around the world. by leveraging their collective capabilities, skills and network

We founded our [Friends of Ukraine](#) project (now H4H) in the first days of war, and grew to become one of Switzerland’s largest volunteer initiatives. During first year, we:

- 1 we have provided **over 200 tons of humanitarian aid** from our bases in Zurich and Geneva
- 2 provided over **500 free telemedical consultations** to Ukrainians in the warzone
- 3 **evacuated several sick children** & matched with doctors in Switzerland
- 4 welcomed nearly **18,000 refugees** and provided them with essential goods and professional counsel.
- 5 conducted several **medical trainings for Ukrainian doctors**
- 6 provided **2 novel insulin delivery solutions** for developing countries



2022 Highlights

- we set up **seven donation points in Zurich and Geneva**, with a central warehouse at Zentralwäscherei in Zurich
- as food, personal care, electronics and clothes flow in, **volunteers from our 700-strong supporter community** work relentlessly to collect, sort and pack these donations
- we open **a refugee centre in Geneva**. Within several months, this centre **welcomes over 18,000 Ukrainians**, providing them with food and essential goods, and helping with immigration and legal counsel. In December 2022, we close the centre
- we gather professional **bakers from the Ukrainian refugee community to organise a charity bake sale with Paskas** — traditional Ukrainian Easter cakes
- We kick off a **Hospital Partnership Programme to connect hospitals in Ukraine and Switzerland**, and to enable all sorts of support to Ukrainian hospitals, from **medical advisory and transfer of the Swiss know-how to provision of required supplies** such as medical equipment, wheelchairs and ambulance cars
- we created **a Swiss-Ukrainian board to manage the evacuation of children** with rare diseases to Switzerland; presented this project to 26 health ministers of Switzerland
- **KSD / Swiss Army is now involved** in an official capacity, managing this evacuation project
- we negotiated with a major medical sensor supplier the **donation of 4,000 sensors to Ukrainian hospitals**
- we granted access to the **videos of Swiss Medi Kids** to Ukrainian doctors, and **translated all materials to Ukrainian**
- we transported **80 wheelchairs donated by Swiss clinics** to several hospital groups in Ukraine
- In December, we launched our first campaign: **Fit for Winter. We engage several new partners in Ukraine, Poland and Switzerland to provide sleeping bags and warmers to Ukrainian maternity homes to keep these infants warm**



What support we can give?

- **Using our network in the medical industry** we can help to procure, export and correctly deliver specific goods and supplies
- Our connections in the Ukrainian government, particularly within the **Ministry of Defense and the Ministry of Healthcare**, allow us to guarantee **deliveries within Ukraine** (and not its borders)
- We provide all sorts of goods, such as food, clothes, electronics and personal care items
- We can help arrange a medical emergency transfer to Switzerland

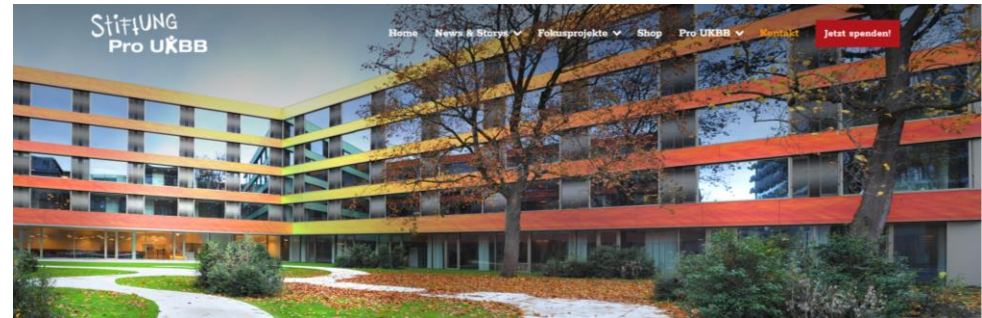
