### Information about the institution

Communal non-profit enterprise "Zakarpattia Regional Children's Sanatorium" Malyatko "" is a medical institution owned by the Zakarpattia Regional Council.

The institution is located in the Transcarpathian region in the village of Onokivtsi, accommodates 80 people at a time, has a convenient transport connection and a large park area.

The institution has the first accreditation category. There is a valid license to conduct business in medical practice on the basis of the order of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine from 20.01.2020 №116 in various specialties, including pediatrics, pediatric allergology, medical psychology, physical and rehabilitation medicine, pediatric neurology, pediatric orthopedics and traumatology etc.

Until 2020, the institution provided sanatorium-health resort treatment of children with respiratory pathology only. In connection with the health care reform of Ukraine, we have expanded the range of services and introduced medical rehabilitation for children with musculoskeletal and nervous system disorders. For this purpose, retraining of specialists was carried out and appropriate equipment was received.

The institution has four buildings for patients, a physiotherapy office, a laboratory, a laundry, a cooking department, two boiler rooms (gas, solid fuel) etc. A feature is the presence on the territory of the equestrian club "Sivka", which has 5 horses, which are used in the rehabilitation process and give good results for children with disabilities. In addition to horses, there are sheep, hares, chickens etc, which are used for animal therapy.

Currently, the institution employs pediatricians, medical psychologist, doctors of physical and rehabilitation medicine, physical therapists, nurses, junior staff and more. There are also two candidates of medical sciences (PhD) in the specialty "Medical Rehabilitation, Physiotherapy and Balneology".

The material-technical base is represented by diagnostic equipment for computer spirometry, electrocardiography and rheovasography; hematological and biochemical analyzers. Rehabilitation equipment includes devices for mechanotherapy, electrotherapy, magnetic therapy, ultrasound therapy, inhalation, oxygen therapy, wheelchairs, crutches, functional beds, balls of various shapes and sizes, balancing platforms, kits for the development of fine motor skills etc.

The sanatorium took part in the international project "Joint initiative to improve the quality of life of children with oncological diseases in Transcarpathia, Kosice and Presov region" (HUSKROUA/1702/8.2/0127) program of cross-border cooperation

Hungary-Slovakia-Romania-Ukraine 2014-2020 Public organization "Council for the Protection of the Rights of Patients and Medical Workers". According to the program, our institution received modern medical equipment and began to do a rehabilitation children with oncopathology in the non-acute period.

The sanatorium has experience rehabilitation for children with disabilities, including children with cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, children with autism spectrum disorders, oncopathology, diabetes, asthma and more. All children undergo rehabilitation in post-acute period.

Until 2020, the institution organized summer health camps, where children could receive medical services aimed at improving their physical and functional condition.

Our team cooperates with Uzhhorod National University, various public organizations.

The reconstruction of the building (which was completed last year) is important for the development of the institution. The building provides modern offices (room) for the diagnostic and rehabilitation services in outpatient and inpatient settings.

Considering the available experience, staff and material-technical base, the sanatorium "Malyatko" is looking for partners for further development of the institution in accordance with European standards of rehabilitation.

Today in Ukraine, a speedy change in priorities was occur. The rehabilitation service in our country is only in its formation. There are no clear protocols for providing rehabilitation assistance.

As a result of active hostilities, the number of victims who will need long-term rehabilitation will increase. We need rapid change to meet the needs of the post-war period.

Cooperation with European partners will provide an opportunity to make extensive use of the existing potential of the institution in order to improve the quality of life of children and their families.
